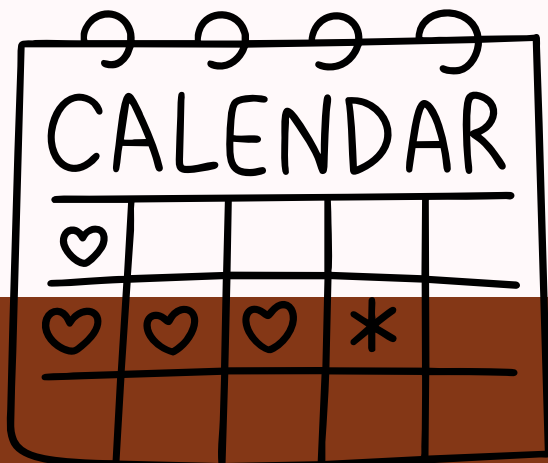


Enjoy Holiday Evenings at the Historic Dade County Courthouse

First Day Hikes

Cloudland Canyon

FIRST DAY HIKE

January 1, 2026

Tradition has it that whatever you're doing on the first day of the new year you will be doing for the rest of the year. Make sure that yours is healthy and in the outdoors by coming on one of our "First Day" hikes! We have three to choose from this year with different lengths and degrees of difficulty. Pick the one that suits you best!

First Day Hike #1: Sittons Gulch Trail to Hemlock Falls - 9:30 AM - 12:30 PM. Hike with a park Naturalist through the canyon bottom to Hemlock Falls on the beautiful Sitton Gulch trail. This is a four mile round trip and is moderately strenuous. Meet at the Interpretive Center at 9:30 AM, then you'll drive down to the Sitton Gulch trailhead.

First Day Hike #2: West Rim Loop trail - 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM. A park Naturalist will take you to see some of the most scenic views in the park on this three mile loop trail. This is a moderately easy trail. Meet at the Interpretive Center at 11:30 AM, then you'll drive to the West Rim trailhead. Bring water and snacks!

First Day Hike #3: Overlook Trail to the Meadowlands - 2:00 PM - 3:30 PM. Join a park Naturalist on this easy two mile round trip hike to the Meadowlands and back. Meet at the Interpretive Center at 2:00 PM.

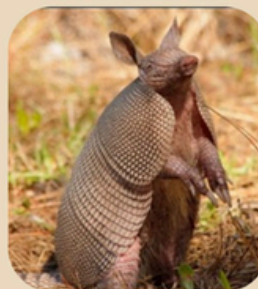

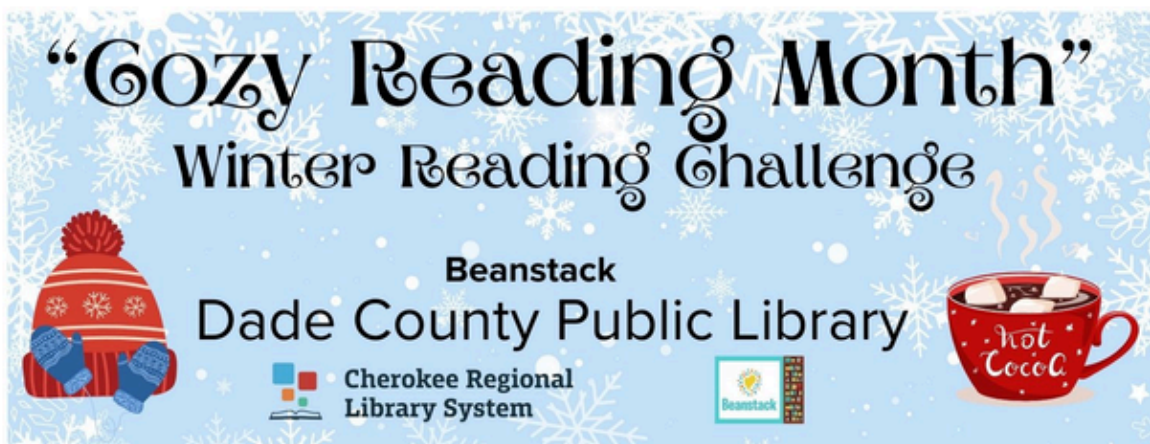
