# **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Career Fair.** Josh Ingle presented an idea for the Alliance to sponsor a Career Fair for Dade County High School students on April 5, 2022. Two teachers, Pam Barton and Tanya Gatlin, will assist. 154 students will be graduating this year and approximately 70% will not be going on to college, creating an opportunity for local employers to find new workers. Students will carousel around the employer displays in the morning. The high school will provide lunch for the employers. In the afternoon, employers will have the opportunity to tour the high school tech classrooms. The board agreed this is a great opportunity and will move forward with the idea.

**Dade Library Prime Time Reading Program**. Charity reported that she has contacted Mindy Haworth at the library and plans are in place for the Alliance to provide dinner on the first night of the program, February 8. Charity will coordinate with those who have volunteered to bring food on number of people and time specifics.

**Drugs Don't Work Program**. Stacey reported that she has spoken with Chuck Wade and will be doing the two-hour zoom training session soon. We received a box of materials at the Welcome Center and Stacey will pick up and review.

**Public Art**. William Back reported that the committee has added a new member, LeeAnne Johnson Absolom, who has experience with a web presence for art. The committee is searching for private property owners willing to display sculpture, and is hoping that city and county will follow suit. They are also exploring grant opportunities

**Membership Renewals**. Marcy reported that to date in 2022, we have received \$6,100 in renewals and \$650 from new investors. We have not yet received renewal payments from Dade County, City of Trenton, Citizen's Bank, or Integer – some of our largest contributors. Marcy will send out renewal notices each month to Investors reaching their renewal date.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Tourism.** Charity reported that she received information that the cost to print 15-20,000 tourist maps would be \$1,500-2,000 plus graphics development. Todd has not contacted any businesses about purchasing advertising. The board agreed that we should pursue a different company to help create a tourism map. Marcy promised to send information to Charity about other marketing companies who have presented at GACCE.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Lunch & Learn.** Scheduled for February 24<sup>th</sup>, the theme will be "Community Update". Ted Rumley, Alex Case, and Josh Ingle will present. Marcy got a quote from Catering by Alan at \$20 per person. Kathleen and Dorinda suggested other caterers to contact. The board agreed we should raise the price for the Lunch & Learn to \$15 for Investors and \$18 for Non-Investors.

**Consignment artwork sales at the Welcome Center.** Marcy asked the board to consider allowing the Welcome Center to provide our local artists with an outlet for selling their work, with a percentage of the sales price going to the Alliance. William Back provided guidance that the portion of the sale price received by the Alliance must be deemed a contribution from the artist to the Alliance. Since there is a \$500 exemption for sales tax in Georgia, we will probably no have to pay sales tax. We will not need a business license because our income would be intermittent and below the threshold required for a business license. The board agreed this is a good idea and Marcy will work with William to create a written agreement between the Alliance and the Artist and Marcy will develop a procedure for Titus to handle sales. Harry mentioned that we can get a credit card reader at minimal cost and will check to verify that it will work with our payment gateway.

# **OPEN FLOOR**

Kathleen proposed that the Alliance volunteer at the 1945 Dade County Fair. She agreed to lead a committee to put plans together for the Alliance to manage the Information Tent at the Fair, as well as

cutting the watermelon for the watermelon eating contest and cooking the hot dogs for the hot dog eating contest. The topic will be added to next month's agenda.
