When & Where?	SATURDAY, AUGUST 12 10 am to 4:30 pm Event Center at Dade County High School 300 Tradition Lane Trenton, GA 30752 (just 20 miles from downtown Chattanooga)		
Who should apply?	Anyone who produces original, quality works of art, crafts, or other cool artistic stuff. You needn't be famous. We know that art comes in many forms and media, and we'll gladly consider all ideas, concepts, and designs for inclusion in the event.  We're looking for a broad variety of art – a few specific requirements (and we know this is an incomplete list!)		
	Jewelry	Must be hand-made (except for metal chains and fasteners).	
	Pottery	Must be hand-made or thrown and fired.	
	Wooden items	Must be hand-crafted, fully assembled, sanded, and finished.	
	Clothing, Accessories or Textile Art	Must be designed, interpreted by, and sewn, knitted, or woven.	
	Photography	May be original or reproduced. We recommend that photos be matted, framed, or plastic-wrapped.	
	Painting and Drawing	Must be original or print. May be in any medium.	
	Sculpture	Must be an original. Must be secure from tipping over.	
	Light sculpture	Must contain UL-approved components.	
	Glass	Must be cut from your own original pattern or blown.	
	Plastic / Acrylic / Plexiglass	Must be securely assembled.	
Reserving Your Space	The show will be held inside, in an air-conditioned space. Each exhibit space is 12' x 12'. You may rent more than one space. Bring your own tables, chairs, and display pieces.		
Fees	Non-refundable payment for display space is due upon application.  Alliance for Dade Investors: \$30 per space Non-Investors \$60 per space  EARLY BIRD SPECIAL! Register before June 16, 2023 and save 25%!		
Promotion	We'll promote the event in Chattanooga, Dade County & the tri-state area on social media, radio, newspapers, and road signs.		
Parking and Set-up	Maps, parking and unloading instructions will be sent by August 5. Set-up will be from 6pm – 8pm on Friday evening, August 11 and 8:30 to 9:30 a.m. on the morning of the event, August 12.

## RULES FOR EXHIBITORS



- 1. The Plum Nelly Depot Art Show<sup>SM</sup> staff reserves the right to prohibit the sale of any merchandise which is offensive in nature.
- 2. Pets and helium balloons are not permitted in the Plum Nelly Depot Art Show.
- 3. Open flames are prohibited
- 4. The Plum Nelly Depot Art Show<sup>SM</sup> is a 100% tobacco-free event. Cigarettes and other tobacco products (including vaping) are prohibited on all DCHS properties, including in vehicles, parking lots, outside areas, and all facilities.
- 5. All artwork and display equipment must fit within your 12' x 12' marked space. There will be no storage area supplied. Exhibitors are not allowed to block the aisles by displaying or sitting outside of their exhibit space.
- 6. Upon request, one outlet plug will be provided to each space at a charge of \$10 (limited availability). The reservation for the electrical outlet must be made in advance. Electrical load cannot exceed 110 volts, 10 amps. Extension cords or power strips are the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Misuse or overload of electrical circuit will result in immediate disconnection and forfeiture of electrical outlet rental fee.
- 7. Exhibits must be set by opening at 10am on Saturday, August 12, 2023, and staffed by individuals over the age of 18 until closing at 4:30 pm. All participants must follow the load-in and load-out schedules stated in the confirmation letter that will be sent to you.
- 8. Alliance for Dade cannot guarantee the safety of materials. Although the school will be locked, no security guard will be on duty overnight. By signing the Registration Form, Exhibitors release the Alliance for Dade from responsibility for damage or theft.
- 9. All transactions between the Exhibitor and customer are the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors must have their own change funds. The customer has the right to request and receive a receipt. The collection and remittance of Georgia Sales Tax is the responsibility of each Exhibitor. Sales tax questions should be directed to Georgia Department of Revenue.
- 10. There will be no refunds, and exhibit spaces are not transferable.
- 11. Rules are subject to change. Continued participation of the Exhibitor is at the discretion of the Plum Nelly Depot Art Show<sup>SM</sup> staff.
- 12. Exhibitor shall protect, maintain, save and hold harmless the Alliance for Dade, Inc., its officers, agents, servants and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, expense and liabilities arising out of injury or death to any person, or the damage, loss or destruction of any property which may occur in or about the venue (including any portion thereof which Exhibitor has not been given the right to occupy or use pursuant to the terms of this Agreement) or which may arise or in any way grow out of any act or omission of Exhibitor, its agents, invitees and patrons' use and occupancy of venue.
- 13. Failure to follow any of the above rules will result in dismissal from the Plum Nelly Depot Art Show<sup>SM</sup> and will forfeit future participation.
