












In an effort to boost interest and the number of workers in skilled trade careers, TV personality Mike Rowe has awarded partial scholarships to five students at a lineman school in Dade County.

Rowe, known for hosting the shows "Dirty Jobs" and "Somebody's Gotta Do It," made the announcement late last month on social media. His work ethic grant program was started 15 years ago and has awarded about \$8 million to 2,000 people, the announcement said. This year, Rowe awarded a total of \$675,000 to 124 people, including five men who started their 15-week lineman training course at the Trenton-based Southeast Lineman Training Center this week.

The scholarship is for people learning skilled trades rather than going to a traditional four-year university.


