Northern Alabama and Southern Middle Tennessee



Tonight-Thu

- Dry and bitterly cold
- Highs in the 35-40F range (colder in elevated terrain)
- Lows in the 23-27F tonight, and in the 15-20F range Thu morning (with colder wind chills)

Thu Night-Sat Morning

- Bitter cold persists
- High (70-90%) chance of accumulating winter precipitation
 - Monitoring potential precipitation type - could be all snow or mix of sleet/freezing rain and snow
- Confidence in accumulating snow and travel impacts is increasing

NOTE: A change of just a few degrees will change the forecast, stay tuned for the latest updates.




The River to Clouds Route is a multi-use route that traverses Lookout Mountain. Approximately 34 miles in length, the route begins at Cloudland Canyon State Park near Rising Fawn, Georgia, and follows the mountain north to the base of Lookout Mountain in Chattanooga, Tennessee where it connects to Chattanooga's Greenway System. This multi-use route is open to bicycles and foot travel, consisting of both single and double-track trails.

The RCR challenges the most seasoned adventure cyclists, runners, and hikers. Users can expect to encounter rocky technical sections, scenic overlooks, tumbling mountain streams, waterfalls, hidden hollers, unique rock formations, abandoned mines, and several historical sites.

The River to Clouds Route links together several public lands managed by different organizations, including Lookout Mountain Conservancy, National Park Service, Lula Lake Land Trust, Georgia-Alabama Land Trust, Covenant College, and Georgia State Parks. To find out where you can park overnight and camp, please consult the map and make sure to follow the rules and guidelines set by each land manager.
