DPH Launches Voluntary Awareness Training for EMS Personnel

The EMS training is in conjunction with Human Trafficking Prevention Month and provides an opportunity to raise awareness and combat this heinous crime.

All Georgians are encouraged to take part in the First Lady's Human Trafficking Awareness Training. The training will also be available to the public on <u>YOUTube</u> as a free and easily-accessible resource.

To report suspected human trafficking in Georgia, call the Statewide 24-Hour Human Trafficking Hotline at 1-866-ENDHTGA (1-866-363-4842). If you have reason to believe that a victim is in imminent danger, call 911 or your local law enforcement agency to file a report.


