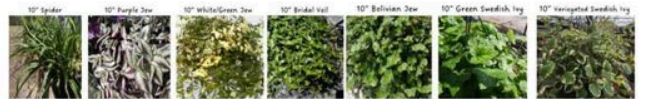

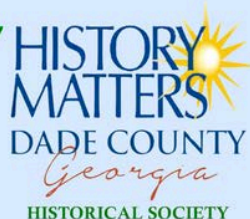

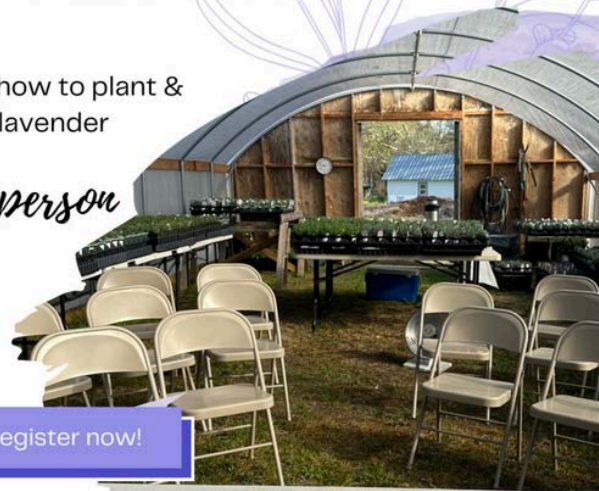

Dazzling Darters
of Georgia
March 2, 8, 9, 15, 16, 22, 23, 28
10:00 AM

Dive into the freshwater world of darters! We will explore the threats impacting populations and the conservation efforts to help protect these interesting and imperiled fish. Duration = 1 hr.



Scats and Tracks
March 8, 15, 22, 28
1:00 PM

During this program you will learn methods for identifying common wildlife scat and tracks found in North Georgia. Duration = 1 hr.



Let's ROCK!
March 2, 3, 7, 12, 14, 17, 19, 21, 23
10:00 AM

Explore the geologic forces that formed the canyon and the surrounding area. This moderately strenuous hike begins at the Main Overlook and proceeds down to Cherokee Falls. Duration = 1.5 - 2 hours.



Cawwww! of the Corvids
March 2, 7, 10, 18, 24
1:00 PM

Crows are among the most intelligent and social animals on the planet. This program will give you the low-down on them and the other members of the Corvid family. Duration = 1 hr.



Going... Going... Gone!

Many species of plants and animals, including some in our park are imperiled, or threatened. Come find out what they are, and what's being done to ensure their survival.



Tied up in KNOTS

Winter Greenery

This guided walk along the Overlook Trail introduces you to some of the trees and plants in the park that stay green all winter long. Duration = 1 hr. +.



West Rim Hike

This Ranger led hike takes you down into the canyon and up the west side to a rocky outcrop on the West Rim Trail. Moderately strenuous. Duration = 2.5 hrs.



Flying to the Future

What's in Sitton Gulch

The wildflowers in Sitton gulch are in bloom! Come see what's up along the Sitton Gulch Trail. Meet at the Interpretive Center, then we'll drive down the mountain to the lower trailhead. Duration = 1 - 1 1/2 hrs.



Meadowlands Hike
March 14, 19, 25, 27

Take a walk with the Park's Naturalist from the Interpretive Center along the Overlook Trail to the Meadowlands and back. This is a moderate two mile hike RT. Duration = 2 hrs.



Holes Geocached
Caves and Karst of the Cumberland Plateau
March 1, 5, 9, 14, 20
1:00 PM

Cloudland Canyon is the only state park in Georgia that lies within the Cumberland Plateau, and the only one that contains caves. This 1 hr. presentation explains why this region is riddled with holes, and will introduce you to the fragile environment of caves and some of the fascinating creatures found in them. Duration is 1hr. +



Turtles of Georgia
March 4, 11, 18, 24, 31
10:00 AM

Learn about the different turtles of Georgia, and which one has been designated the "State Reptile"! Duration = 45 mins.



BEAR CREEK HIKE
March 3, 19, 21

This short but strenuous hike will go from the Interpretive Center down to the ford at Bear Creek. Duration = 2 hrs.



Tarpology 101
March 8, 22, 29

Learn to build a variety of simple shelters using tarps. Duration = 1 hr.



GOING DEEP
Geology of the Canyon Bottom
March 5, 13, 28
10:00 AM

Explore the geologic strata of the canyon from the bottom up in this advanced look at the rocks and minerals that make up the lower part of the canyon. Meet at the Interpretive Center, then we'll drive to the lower Sitton Gulch Trailhead. This is a moderate to mile hike. Duration = 2.5 hrs



Clouds in the Canyon

Learn about the different cloud formations and what they're called, and find out how Cloudland Canyon got it's name! Duration = 45 mins - 1 hr.

Every year the Interpretive Rangers and part-time Naturalists at Georgia's State Parks and Historic Sites get assigned an annual theme that we base some of our programs and hikes around. This year's theme is 'Wild Georgia - A Plan For Tomorrow', and we'll be highlighting some of the plant and animal species across the state that are rare, threatened, or endangered. Here at Cloudland Canyon we'll put a special emphasis on species in those categories that you might find here in the park, or in this area of the state, and what is being done to conserve them.

Attendees to these programs at any state park can get a special bookmark which can be stamped by the park rangers conducting the programs. Attend four programs and you can send your bookmark off and receive a free gift! Here are the Wild Georgia programs that we have scheduled for March 2025.
