

During this program you will learn methods for identifying common wildlife scat and tracks found in North Georgia. Duration = 1 hr.



Explore the geologic forces that formed the canyon and the surrounding area. This moderately strenuous hike begins at the Main Overlook and proceeds down to Cherokee Falls. Duration = 1.5 -2 hours.



Crows are among the most intelligent and social animals on the planet. This program will give you the low-down on them and the other members of the Corvid family. Duration = 1hr.



Going... Many species of plants and animals, including some inCone our park are imperiled, or threatened. Come find out what they are, and what's being done to ensure their survival.



Learn some of the most useful knots to use around your campsite during this short hands-on program. Duration = 1 hr.



This guided walk along the Overlook Trail introduces you to some of the trees and plants in the park that stay green all winter long. Duration = 1hr. +.



West Rim This Ranger led hike takes you down into the canyon and up the west side to a rocky outcrop on the West Rim Trail. Moderately strenuous. Duration = 2.5 hrs.



Eagles, hawks, falcons, and ravens are some of Georgia's largest birds, and among its most imperiled. Come learn about these and other large avians, and the efforts to slow their decline. Duration = 1hr.



The wildflowers in Sitton gulch are in bloom! Come see what's up along the Sitton Gulch Trail. Meet at the Interpretive Center, then we'll drive down the mountain to the lower trailhead. Duration = 1 - 11/2 hrs.



Take a walk with the Park's Naturalist from the Interpretive Center along the Overlook Trail to the Meadowlands and back. This is a modarate two mile hike RT. Duration = 2 hrs.



Cloudland Canyon is the only state park in Georgia that lies within the Cumberland Plateau, and the only one that contains caves. This 1 hr. presentation explains why this region is riddled with holes, and will intrdouce you to the fragile environment of caves and some of the fascinating creatures found in them. Duration is 1hr. +



Learn about the different turtles of Georgia, and which one has been designated the "State Reptile"!

Duration = 45 mins.



This short but strenuous hike will go from the Interpretive Center down to the ford at Bear Creek. Duration = 2 hrs.



Learn to build a variety of simple shelters using tarps. Duration = 1 hr.



Explore the geologic strata of the canyon from the bottom up in this advanced look at the caryon from the bot-tom up in this advanced look at the rocks and minerals that make up the lower part of the canyon. Meet at the Interpretive Center, then we'll drive to the lower Sitton Gulch Trailhead. This is a moderate to mile hike. Duration = 2.5 hrs



Learn about the different cloud formations and what they're called, and find out how Cloudland Canyon got it's name! Duration = 45 mins - 1 hr.
